



Serving Opportunities at Horizon

AV Team

The aptly-named AV Team is responsible for managing the various audio and visual elements for church services. Team members make adjustments on our sound board, run lyrics and sermon slides, and ensure all of our media is organized and ready before worship starts. Experience is NOT necessary, all training is provided.

Care Team

Be a part of a team that helps provide meals for families within the church who have someone facing a serious illness/surgery, or suffer bereavement of immediate family members.

Community Group Host

Host a Community Group in your home 1-4 X/Month

Community Group Leader

Lead a Community Group 1-4X/Month. This does not necessarily need to be in your home.

Children's Ministry

Substitute Sunday School teachers: Available to serve as needed as a substitute for Children's Sunday School on Sundays at 9am

One-on-one Aides: Individuals interested in sitting with and being a "buddy" to children with special needs and/or younger children getting accustomed to kidZ Church and the larger crowd. Would serve on a monthly basis.

Sign-In: Serve on a monthly or bi-weekly basis during Sunday School hour, signing children in.

kidZ Church Workers: AV Tech, Helper, Teacher, during Sunday Service (not every week)

Drama Team

Got a flair for the dramatic? Sign up to be a part of Horizon's drama team.

Digital Media

If you've got a creative spark, are tech savvy, and would like to use your gifts to assist with digital media needs at Horizon Church, this is the place for you. Flexible – 1 to 10 hrs/month.

ESL Ministry

Childcare Helper- Serve once/month in the nursery helping the staff to care for the children (12 and under) of our ESL students

Snack Provider - Help provide a snack for ESL adult students once/semester for their monthly fellowship time.

ESL Teacher Assistant/Substitute – Assisting an ESL teacher with a small group of 4-10 adult students, Mondays from 6:30-8pm. No experience necessary and you do not need to know another language.

Facilities/Grounds Team

Assist with upkeep of church building (inside and outside). Projects assigned by availability and ability.

Good News Club, Grade Shepherd

Have fun getting to know your small group of 7-10 children (of the same elementary school grade level) in the Good News Club after-school program Horizon Church helps sponsor! Meets at Mauldin Elementary for a little over an hour. Time commitment is most school calendar Tuesdays, 2:00-4:30.

Greeter

Arrive at church 20-30 minutes before worship service begins. Give warm and inviting welcome to visitors by opening doors, giving directions, and making worshippers feel comfortable in a new environment. Serve 1-2 X/quarter.

Hospitality/Coffee Bar

Brew the coffee on Sunday mornings and be everyone's hero! Two shifts available: 1) 8:15-9:00am or 2) 9:45-10:15 plus 15 min. of clean up after the service. Once/month commitment.

Nursery

Assist with children in the infant or toddler nursery Sunday mornings from 8:50-9:55 or from 9:45-11:10 once every 8 weeks or as a sub.

Operation Christmas Child

Committed Year-Round volunteers to (1) help organize and plan OCC events, (2) keep donations inventoried and organized, (3) assist in planning and running the yearly packing party in November. Approximate time commitment: 1-2 hours per month, 2-4 hours the week before the packing party, and available the day of the packing party.

Office Help

Help with data entry, making copies, filing, etc. in the church office for 1-2 hours/month, quarter, or semester.

Praise Team

Instrumentalists: If you play guitar, bass, drums, woodwind, brass, string, or percussion, we have a place for you! You can play regularly or just once in a while.

Singers: If you like to sing either as a soloist, backup singer, or in a choir, we also have a place for you!

Usher

Having informed, friendly and helpful ushers is vital to the efficient running of our service and allows our attendees to feel welcome and at home in our church. Be a part of a team that serves in the service each Sunday morning for two months of the year. Arrive at 9:40 am on your scheduled weeks.

Youth Ministry

Discussion Group Leader - following each Wednesday night service, HYP breaks into small groups by age and gender to help cover the material from the message on a more relevant level. Looking for College and older individuals grounded in their faith to expand upon the topics covered at HYP. Can serve once or weekly (3x/mo)!

Snack Provider - HYP students tend to be constantly hungry! We try to provide fun and filling snacks before each service. All talent levels (Walmart shopping capable to Pinterest master) accepted! 1x per week/month.

Young Spirited and Able to Drive - Do you wish you could justify shooting paintballs or hiking or playing awesome games on the weekends? If you're still a kid at heart but have a driving license, we could use you to help transport for HYP events! Needs vary by event.
